



PRIVATE CONTRACT WITH MEDICARE BENEFICIARY

This agreement is between Dr. McGregor (“Physician”) and all providers at Integrative Medical Clinic of NC, PLLC, whose principal place of business is 5915 Farrington Rd, Suite 106, Chapel Hill, NC 27517, and patient _____ (“Patient”), who resides at _____ and is a Medicare Part B beneficiary seeking Services covered under Medicare Part B pursuant to Section 4507 of the Balanced Budget Act of 1997.

Physician has informed Patient that Physician has opted out of the Medicare program effective on January 1, 2024, for a period of at least two years and is not excluded from participating in Medicare Part B under Sections 1128, 1156, 1892 or any other section of the Social Security Act. Physician agrees to provide the following Medical Services to Patient (the “Services”): Evaluation & Management, Consultation and Professional Component Services. In exchange for the Services, the Patient agrees to make payments at time of service to Physician pursuant to the Physician’s Fee. Estimates are available upon request. Patient also agrees, understands, and expressly acknowledges the following:

- Patient agrees not to submit a claim (or to request that Physician submit a claim) to the Medicare program with respect to the Services, even if covered by Medicare Part B.
- Patient is not currently in an emergency or urgent health care situation.
- Patient acknowledges that neither Medicare’s fee limitations nor any other Medicare reimbursement regulations apply to charges for the Services.
- Patient acknowledges that MediGap (Medicare Supplement) plans will not provide payment or reimbursement for the Services because payment is not made under the Medicare program, and other supplemental insurance plans may likewise deny reimbursement.
- Patient acknowledges that he or she has a right, as a Medicare beneficiary, to obtain Medicare-covered items and services from physicians and practitioners who have not opted out of Medicare, and that the patient is not compelled to enter into private contracts that apply to other Medicare-covered services furnished by other physicians or practitioners who have not opted out.
- Patient agrees to be responsible to make payment in full for the Services at time of service and acknowledges that Physician will not submit a Medicare claim for the Services and that no Medicare reimbursement will be provided.
- Patient understands that Medicare payment will not be made for any items or services furnished by the physician that would have otherwise been covered by Medicare if there was no private contract and a proper Medicare claim was submitted.
- Patient acknowledges that a copy of this contract has been made available to him or her.
- Patient agrees to reimburse Physician for any costs and reasonable attorney fees that result from violation of this Agreement by Patient or his beneficiaries.
